## Vulnerable = Making a Move With No Guarantee of the Outcome

<u>Mark 10:46-49</u>—"Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and His disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (which means "son of Timaeus"), was sitting <u>by the roadside begging</u>. <u>When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth</u>, he began to shout, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' <u>Many rebuked him</u> and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stopped and said, 'Call him.'…"

## We Learn That...

#### 1) Begging Kept Him Bound

<u>Mark 10:46</u>—"...As Jesus and His disciples...were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus...was sitting by the roadside begging."

<u>Mark 10:47</u>—"When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!""

#### 2) Playing It Safe Is Dangerous

Mark 10:47—"...he began to shout, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!""

## 3) There's Going To Be Opposition

<u>Mark 10:48</u>—"Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!""

<u>Mark 10:49</u>—"Jesus stopped and said, 'Call him.' So they called to the blind man, 'Cheer up! On your feet! He's calling you.'"

<u>Mark 10:50</u>—"Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus."

<u>Mark 10:51</u>—"What do you want me to do for you?" Jesus asked him. The blind man said, 'Rabbi, I want to see.""
